



How to get to Colibri?

At a lower altitude and enjoying a warmer climate than La Paz, we are located in the town of Jupapina, 35 minutes from La Paz and 5 minutes from the town of Mallasa where the La Paz Zoo and the Moon Valley are located..

Private transfer.

Please request when making your reservation.

From the airport - We can arrange a transfer to the airport with a reliable local cab company - Price US\$14 - USD\$16 / 140bs - 160 bs.

From the city center -A cab can also be booked in advance to bring you here from the city center - Price US\$7 / 70 bs. (approximate cost)

Taxi

Take a taxi to Calle 4 in the Jupapina area (after Mallasa and the La Paz Zoo). Turn left at the flower mural on Calle 4 and follow the road towards the river until you reach Colibri.

Calle 8 in Calacoto: There are local taxi companies that know Colibrí. These companies are: Servivalle and Mallasa, you can take this taxi for an approximate cost of 25 Bs.

Teleférico – Cable Car

Take the Cable Car to the end of the Green Line at Irpavi (Calle 13 de Calacoto) Walk 10 minutes to Plaza Humbolt on Calle 8 de Calacoto and follow the instructions described above.





Mini Buses

There are several minibuses and it costs about 3.5 Bs.

Get on the minibus with the sign that says “Mallasa o Jupapina” in the window.

Take minibus # 253, 379, 901 on top of the car, from Plaza Belzu, 5 minutes walk from the purple cable car station “Obelisco”. ([see here for google maps](#)) This place is the minibus stop 253, you will see a minibus line under a big sign that says “VETERINARIA”. It will pass through Mallasa before arriving at Jupapina, where you should follow the instructions above.

- There is a minibus line # 231 and #273 from Avenida Buenos Aires to Jupapina. Ask the driver to stop at Calle 4 in Jupapina. The minibus will pass through the following places: Prado, Calle Mexico, Plaza del Estudiante (this is the best place to find them), Teleférico Amarillo - Curva de Holguin, Obrajes, Plaza Humboldt, Calle 8 de Calacoto, Mallasa and finally Jupapina.
- Take any of the minibuses from El Prado that go to Calacoto. Get off the minibus at Calacoto calle 8 or Plaza Humboldt where the minibuses to Jupapina pass (231, 273, 901, 379 and 253). Here there are also local cabs (Taxi Mallasa and Taxi Servivalle) that leave from Plaza Humboldt and will take you to Colibri for 25 bs.

Puma Katari

The Irpavi - Mallasa route has two stops near Colibrí, the U.E. Jupapina stop and the Calle 5 stop.



To take the Puma you can visit the App LaPazBus, where you will see in real time the locations of the pumas and their stops.

The busiest stops are: Teleférico Verde- Irpavi Station and Plaza Humbolt.

It is a recent route of PumaKatari and is operating in the mornings from 7am to 10am and in the afternoons from 6pm to 10pm (Saturdays and Sundays from 4pm). This information is available on the LaPazBus App.

Arriving from the bus terminal

In minibus: From the main bus terminal, go down to the main road of La Paz called 16 de Julio or also known as El Prado, and follow the instructions above.
